

# **Academic Review**

2019-20

The 2019-20 edition of the St. Francis de Sales School's Academic Review is a summary of the academic achievements of 676 young men. This represents an increase of 2 students or 1% from the previous year. This collection of statistics shows the comparisons, when available, with national, state and local populations.

In the spring of 2020, we transitioned to virtual learning due to the COVID pandemic that globally hit our education systems and the world. During this time, students were given a variety of assignments, projects, live lectures, recorded lectures, and assessments to advance them through our curriculum. Students completed their work by the end of the semester and were given letter grades and a corresponding GPA. Additionally, some students completed Advanced Placement Exams. As a testament to the rigor of our virtual learning, St. Francis students earned a passing rate of 78% on Advanced Placement Exams.

Many of the results detailed in this document show the varied academic strengths, which St. Francis de Sales School holds. It should be pointed out that not all academic areas are as strong as others and the school as a whole recognizes this and will make attempts in the present and future to address those deficiencies.

As always, our academic initiatives are included in this document and hopefully will promote academic excellence at SFS for several years to come.


# **ACT Graphical Comparison to Ohio and National Averages**















# **Advanced Placement Score Analysis**

Advanced Placement ("AP") Exams are scored on a scale from one to five. Scores of three, four, and five are considered passing grades and are awarded college credit by most colleges and universities in the United States. In the spring of 2020, an unprecedented event happened worldwide where The College Board was faced to give all AP exams virtually. They had approximately 5 weeks to create over 38 secure virtual exams to give to over 4.6 million high school students worldwide. In May of 2020, 162 St. Francis de Sales students (a decrease of 9 students from the previous year) took 277 AP Exams (a decrease of 17 exams from the previous year). The school as a whole passed 78% of the examinations. The Global passing rate is 65.74% for the same exams. In 2019-20 the school's passing rate was 75%.

Our AP program is very strong as you can see by our scores. After the Spring 2020 exams, 7 or our AP teachers were chosen from thousands of AP teachers across the world to grade AP exams in their discipline during the first two weeks of June. The disciplines were, Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, Biology, Economics, French and Computer Science. This is an honor for both the teachers and St. Francis. College Board paid for all expenses for these teachers!





#### Academic Initiatives for the 2019-20 School Year

St. Francis de Sales School continues to reflect and review our curriculum to challenge and meet our students where they are in their education and help them be successful for the next level. We continue to revise our course offerings to prepare our students for college or the workforce. We have added the following courses and other hands on opportunities for our students to learn and explore a wide range of knowledge.

1. The Math Department expanded its math offerings to help students who struggle in the math concepts and create a solid foundation before moving into their upper level math courses.

Algebra Concepts – This class is offered to Freshmen only.

This course is intended to help students make the transition from middle school math to high school algebra. Topics covered include: operations with fractions and decimals, order of operations, operations with real numbers, solving equations, proportions, inequalities, graphing linear equations, solving systems of equations, and exponent properties.

2. Our Center for Advanced Scientific Exploration phase one was completed during the summer of 2019 with completion of our Human Performance Laboratory (HPL). The HPL is an interdisciplinary laboratory equipped with state-of-the art technology and equipment dedicated to the expansion of knowledge of the human anatomy, physiology, exercise physiology, biomechanics and the promotion of physical fitness, health, wellness and nutrition.

The goals of the HPL are:

- Advance the integrated study of Science, Technology, Engineering and Math (STEM)
- Enhance and expand existing curriculum through "myPREP".
- Create and promote opportunities for students to engage in scientific research.
- Develop lifelong healthy habits and lifestyles as it relates to nutrition and wellness through experimental learning.
- Provide data and tools for measuring the increase of students' strength, health and fitness.
- Conduct and assess performance measures such as: cardiorespiratory, endurance, pulmonary function, vision testing, muscle fitness, body motion, flexibility, strength, speed, agility, balance, coordination, reaction time, anaerobic power, aerobic capacity and body composition.
- Provide a solid academic foundation and experience conducive to the pursuit of higher education and careers in medicine, physical therapy, occupational therapy, cardiac or pulmonary rehabilitation, public health and athletic training among others.
- Develop partnership with higher education, stakeholders and professionals in related fields, in order to serve the community at large.

As an objective for the first year, we integrated the HPL into our biology, honors biology and anatomy/physiology classes. We also exposed the new space to our 7<sup>th</sup>/8<sup>th</sup> grade students. As we look into future years, we plan to develop science classes specifically for the HPL that will demonstrate a Christian understanding of the human person in the Salesian Tradition, find a connection between science, one's body, and the rest of the world and research projects. We are hoping that phase two of the Center for Advanced Scientific Exploration will begin the summer of 2021.
